## Changes

### GOVERNOR SERVICES

The existing GovernorHub and GovernorHub Knowledge subscriptions have been combined into one single discounted subscription and there will no longer be an option to subscribe to these separately.

GovernorHub is an online platform, allowing governing boards to keep track of meetings and papers in a data protection compliant system; enabling governors and governance professionals to communicate and store documents, membership details, meeting schedules and other information in one secure and accessible place.

GovernorHub Knowledge offers training and access to a knowledge bank that provides support when governors need it – giving governing boards confidence in their actions and the knowledge to be truly effective.

### SCHOOLS ABSENCE INSURANCE SERVICE

As outlined in correspondence shared with schools earlier this year, the Schools Absence Insurance Service is being phased out and will not be available for academies to purchase from 1 September 2025.

### HEALTH & SAFETY SERVICE

From 1 September 2025, we will no longer be providing Kiln, Pottery and DT inspections meaning schools will need to purchase these services directly from elsewhere going forward.
