Here are just a few of the ways we can help...

- Annual Reading for Pleasure Loans: Reading levels have been impacted by Covid. Our loans can help develop your reading culture at your school, evidence indicates that reading for pleasure can improve empathy, relationships, well-being and reduce symptoms of depression.
- Curriculum topic boxes: These help with lost learning in other areas of the curriculum and are hand-picked to suit your requirements. They include high quality texts at the appropriate key stage and also include artefacts related to the topic.
- Creating great school libraries: We can work with you to help you create engaging and inspiring spaces for your pupils. Evidence shows that school libraries and librarians impact positively on reader enjoyment, attitudes to learning/reading and reading outcomes/attainment. Our team help to transform library spaces with typical work involving stock audits, library management system support, design and layout advice and book recommendations.
- Supporting school staff: Training programme and support, including regular primary and secondary school network meetings for school staff. Telephone/email support and advice services.
- Book Awards, initiatives and events: Various activities for all year groups to inspire and engage your pupils to read for pleasure.
