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Summary

The NHS Outcomes Framework (NHS OF) is a set of indicators developed by the Department of Health to monitor the health outcomes of adults and children in England. The framework provides an overview of how the NHS is performing.

New national, sub-national and demographic indicator values are now available for the following indicators:

- 1c Neonatal mortality and stillbirths
- 1.6.i Infant mortality
- 1.6.ii Five-year survival from all cancers in children
- 2.2 Employment of people with long-term conditions
- 2.5.i Employment of people with mental illness
- 5.6 Patient safety incidents reported
