NRT supply appropriate – once you have selected yes - you can record the product being given to the patient. Remember to record the next appointment date. Click the print consent page on the left hand side – to print of consent – which both client and advisors signs.

Stage 1 is done at the 1st consultation only. If the patient has been put on Champix you will need to complete the registration stage and then go on to Smoking Cessation Stage 2 – Varencline Supply. This section the pharmacist will have to access as they will be required to enter their GPHC number and be accredited to provide Champix

Smoking Cessation Stage 2 – Pharmacological support is completed at every consultation apart from the first consultation.

You are able to print off appointment reminders when you have entered the next appointment date - to do this once you have completed filling Smoking Cessation Stage 2 – enter the next appointment date at the bottom of the screen – then click next appointment reminder on the left hand side of the screen.
