

## Warwickshire 11+ Qualifying Scores - September 2017 Entry

Each of Warwickshire's six grammar schools are their own admission authority and have set their own qualifying scores for 2017 entry. Each school also has its own over-subscription criteria, which have been taken into account where there have been more applicants than places available.

### Information on Qualifying Scores, Waiting List Ranges and Offers

The following information outlines the automatic qualifying scores which have now been established for each of the six Warwickshire grammar schools, as well as the criteria used when making offers for 2017 entry. Also included are details of the minimum score required in order to be placed on the waiting list for each of the grammar schools. These scores have been determined by a Committee of Reference as part of Warwickshire's Local Review Process.

### Late Applications

A place at a Warwickshire grammar school will not have been offered if the application is considered as late or where the applicant has been made an offer for a school listed as a higher preference on the secondary school application.

Applications have also **not** been considered in this first round of offers where **either**;

- the secondary school application was submitted late to the applicant's home authority (ie: past the National deadline of 31<sup>st</sup> October 2016), **or**
- where the applicant was registered late for the 11+ test (ie: past the deadline of 7<sup>th</sup> July 2016), **or**

- where the applicant did not submit satisfactory documentation in support of the address which was named on the application, by the relevant deadline of 30<sup>th</sup> December 2016

If the applicant has not been considered in this first round of offers, for one or more of these reasons, and they achieved at least the 'minimum waiting list score' as outlined above, then they will automatically be added to the waiting list of any grammar school which has been named on the application. Re-offers from the waiting lists will be considered from 20<sup>th</sup> March 2017.

Please note that individual scores for children receiving an offer for a grammar school under Pupil Premium, LAC or EHCP criteria (Categories 1 and 2) are not published in this data due to Data Protection legislation.

*Category 1 of each school's over-subscription criteria relates to children who are in the care of the Local Authority or who were previously looked after, as defined by the School Admissions Code (2014).*

*Children with a statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan will only be allocated a place if they meet the academic requirements of the grammar school for which an application has been made.*

Where a school has not been able to fill up to its Published Admission Number (PAN) using the automatic qualifying score, some offers may have been made to applicants scoring within the waiting list range. These offers are included in the column labelled 'Lowest score offered within criterion'.

It should also be noted that not all children within the lowest category offered for a particular grammar school will have been made an offer. Where there are more applicants in the category than there are places available, the distance from the applicant's home address location to the centre point ("centroid") of the preferred school is taken into account, along with the score obtained in the 11+ test. Please see each school's individual admission arrangements using the website links below for further information about each school's admission arrangements for this year of entry.

## **Waiting Lists**

If any places become available at any of the grammar schools then re-offers from the waiting lists will be made from the 20<sup>th</sup> March 2017 (please note: not necessarily on this date), as the first of three reallocation rounds. The second reallocation round will then commence from 10<sup>th</sup> April and the third reallocation round will commence from 2<sup>nd</sup> May. If there are any further re-offers to make after this time then applicants will be considered as and when vacancies become available.

Waiting lists for the grammar schools will be held according to the admission arrangements and over-subscription criteria for each grammar school, and a child's position is subject to change. **Please note that waiting list positions for the grammar schools will not be available until the week commencing Monday 13<sup>th</sup> March.**

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
