PROPOSED REMOVAL OF SPEED HUMP
ASHLAWN ROAD, RUGBY

Warwickshire County Council propose, under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 to remove the speed hump located between number 39 and 45 Ashlawn Road, Rugby.
