1. Welcome, Introduction and Apologies

The Chair welcomed all to the meeting, invited introductions and noted apologies.

2. Safer Neighbourhood Team Update

Warwickshire Police provided an update on activity since the last meeting of the Forum. Key issues to arise were:

- a) Off Road Biking
- b) Parking around Schools

It was noted that a new safer schools PCSO had been appointed

3. Local Issues

The following issues were noted:

- Cllr Watkins to look into overgrown trees being maintained on Whitehouse Crescent and Paddiford Place.
- Off road bikes (used by both youths and adults) around parks and the Jubilee Centre was an issue. The SNT noted that they are doing frequent patrols of the areas.
- Noted that there were issues around Gypsy and travellers encampments.
- Questions were asked around Bermuda Connectivity

Why was the public consultation ignored?

How will WCC be engaging with local residents to develop a design that address all the safety failings and non compliances of the current project?

Why were the findings of the road safety audit not considered and the design changed prior to public consultation rather than knowingly consultation on a design that was not compliant or safe?

What will neighbourhood team be doing to ensure Bermuda Road is traffic calmed and residents parking retained

Do they actually think it's a good use of public money as opposed to delivering the a444 corridor?

Bermuda Connectivity to be agenda item at next meeting after local concern.

--Noted that NBBC were engaging in the following public consultation during the forthcoming period:

--Potholes and Damage on Bermuda Road, Heathend Junction, Raywoods Road and Croft Road.
